

Arts Council of Pointe Coupee 15th Treasures of Pointe Coupee Art Exhibit May 30-June 1 and June 6-8, 2025



The Treasures of Pointe Coupee Art Exhibit celebrates and showcases local and regional artists and offers an exceptional art experience to the public at large. A "Best in Show" and other ribbons are awarded. The exhibit opens with a reception for participating artists and the community. It continues for two weekends with additional arts-related activities including Art Workshops, Arts Market, Conversations with Artists, Treasure Hunt, and Petite Gallerie exhibit. Details of these activities are publicized closer to the time of the exhibit. The exhibit takes place at The Poydras Center, 500 W. Main Street, in New Roads, Louisiana, during the first two weekends in June.

ART SUBMISSION GUIDELINES - please retain these for your reference

<u>General Guidelines:</u> All artwork must be original. No piece previously exhibited in a Treasures exhibit will be accepted. Artists of all ages are welcome. Artwork must be exhibit-ready: 2-D pieces must be framed or gallery wrapped, ready to hang, with fixtures attached. If there are any special exceptions, please make a note on the submission form. Artists are responsible for insuring artwork.

<u>Artwork Categories:</u> Two-dimensional pieces created on a flat surface by painting, photography, printmaking, drawing, etc. and three-dimensional sculptures created by shaping/combining metal, glass, wood, clay, textiles, polymers, found objects, etc.

Number of Submissions: Each artist may submit one piece of 2-D and/or 3-D work. It is the Exhibit's goal to have as many artists represented as the facility will comfortably accommodate. A second piece in each category may be submitted with the understanding it is on a "space available" basis, at no additional fee. Once all forms are received, the Exhibit will decide if space is available. If so, second submissions listed on the entry form will be taken. If there is only room for some of the second submissions, a random drawing will determine which will be exhibited.

<u>Sponsored Artwork:</u> Original artwork by another artist may be submitted for the exhibit as a sponsored piece. Indicate that it is a sponsored piece on the submission form. A registration fee is required. Priority will be given to artists' submission of their own work.

<u>Submission Deadline:</u> Submission forms must be received or postmarked by FRIDAY, APRIL 18, 2025 by email or mail. No submissions will be accepted after the deadline.

Submission Fees: The submission fee is \$20 for Arts Council members/\$25 for non-members.

Art Intake: Artwork will be received Monday, May 19, 12p-5p and Tuesday, May 20, 9a-4p at the Poydras Center.

<u>Art Pick-Up:</u> All artwork displayed in the exhibit must remain in place for the duration of the exhibit to maintain the integrity of the show. Art pick up is Monday, June 9, 11a-3p at the Poydras Center.

<u>Artwork Sales:</u> Artwork in the exhibit may be listed for sale. Artwork that is sold must remain in place throughout the duration of the exhibit to maintain the integrity of the show. The ACPC facilitates transactions and no commission is charged. If a buyer uses a credit card, the ACPC will be reimbursed by the artist for credit card fees. Checks are mailed to selling artists after Treasures ends.

Arts Market: Participating artists may set up a display of additional artwork for sale on Saturdays during the exhibit from 10a-4p. Artists are responsible for handling sales transactions during this time. There is no fee to participate in the Arts Market.

<u>Silent Auction/Volunteer Opportunities:</u> Participating artists are asked to assist the ACPC in holding a successful event. Please consider donating an art piece for the Silent Auction that supports ACPC activities. There are also volunteer opportunities for assisting with the reception, workshops, greeting, etc. This exhibit is for you, the artist, and we treasure your participation!
